Item No. III-3

To consider and approve the proposal from NIC for Networking / Wi-Fi / UTM and Rack Server

Vide Item No. 95-II.6 of the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting of the AFC held on 15<sup>th</sup> Sep., 2014, approval in principle was granted by the AFC for Campus Wide Networking / Wi-Fi / UTM and Rack Server for an amount of Rs. ~2.76 Crores. The AFC resolved that the procurement is to be made through DGS & D. It was also suggested that such type of work may alternately be given to NIC/NICSI.

For this purpose, NIC submitted an estimate of Rs. ~3.73 Crores. However, as the estimate exceeded the approved budget, a fresh estimate was sought from NIC.

The fresh estimate submitted by NIC is placed as Annexure 'VI' for consideration and approval.


